

Further to my email yesterday, I am now in a position to respond to your request for information of 23 January 2015 for “the Wales Audit Office’s response to the APB’s Discussion Paper: “The Audit Report – A Time for Change?” published in December 2007”.

Please find attached a letter that meets the description of your request. I have redacted the mobile phone number of Mr Terry Jones, as that information falls within the section 40(2) (personal information) exemption of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The exemption applies because disclosure would breach the data protection principles of the Data Protection Act 1998.
