



Please note: This code has not been updated since the Data Protection Act 2018 became law. We are working on updating the code and have launched a call for views. The updated code will explain and advise on changes to data protection legislation where these changes are relevant to data sharing. It will address key aspects of the new legislation including transparency, lawful bases for processing, the new accountability principle and the requirement to record processing activities.
